Position: Alumnae Development Chair

Responsibilities: Alumnae Relations is responsible for building and maintaining communication with former HUWIB members to serve as resources for those part of the HUWIB network, particularly through maintaining and enhancing the HUWIB Alumnae Database. The committee reaches out to alumnae and hosts alumnae events, both on campus and in cities across the nation.

Position: Career Development Chair

Responsibilities: The Career Development Committee coordinates the educational and professional development of HUWIB's members through workshops, networking events, collaboration with HBS, professor dinners, panels, mentorship, and other programs. This year, the committee will particularly focus on increasing educational opportunities about a wide range of industries. **The Committee will also include 2 Innovation Directors who will continue the work of the former Innovation Committee by organizing innovation-related networking events, panels, startup internships, and mentorship pairings with VC/entrepreneurial firms.**

Position: Community Outreach Chair (*formerly "External Initiatives"*)

Responsibilities: The Community Outreach Committee will drive initiatives to educate high school students and give back to the local Boston community. As such, the committee will focus on organizing YWBLC, as well as spearhead HUWIB's internal and external philanthropy/scholarships initiatives.

Position: Diversity Chair (*new position in 2018*)

Responsibilities: The Diversity Committee will organize and execute WIB Allies and WIB's Social Impact Conference (**which will combine the former Innovation Competition and former IWIB conferences. This conference will have a particular focus on social innovation, diversity, and philanthropy.**) The committee will also compile lists of local speakers who specialize in promoting or who represent diversity, working with the rest of HUWIB to increase the prevalence of diversity throughout the organization.

Position: Expeditions Chair (*formerly "Outreach"*)

Responsibilities: The Expeditions Committee will facilitate the professional development of HUWIB members by exposing them to the various opportunities available in the business world after graduation. The Committee organizes annual Career Exploratory trips: one to New York in the spring and another to an international location in the winter. This year, the Committee will also coordinate SWL (Society of Women Leaders), **including collaborating with Stanford's WIB**

to plan a joint exploratory trip to Silicon Valley (which will have a particular emphasis on entrepreneurial, tech-related career opportunities).

Position: Intercollegiate Business Convention Co-Chairs (2)

Responsibilities: The IBC Committee will be responsible for planning HUWIB's largest event, the Intercollegiate Business Convention. IBC is the world's largest female undergraduate business conference. This year's Chairs will play a critical role in determining the future vision for IBC, particularly regarding its venue, cost structure, size, and scholarships.

Position: Marketing Chair
